APRIL '67 OPERATION LEJEUNE MAJOR ARMY ELEMENTS WENT INTO NORTHERN BINH DINH, CRESCENT AND I CORPS, CASUALTIES MOUNTED FOR BOTH BATTALIONS IN THESE MOVEMENTS CRESCENDING IN MAY.
